

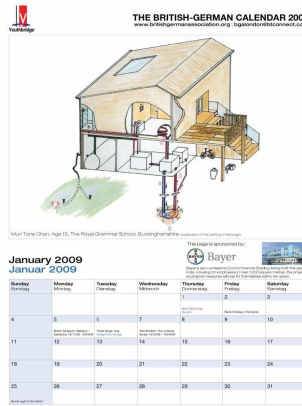

To explain a little bit about the calendar:

The calendar is the result of a Youthbridge cross-curricular competition among pupils whose schools throughout Britain are part of the British-German Association's *Youthbridge scheme* which, through corporate sponsorship and fundraising supports the teaching of German in British state schools all of which have partner schools in Germany.

The purposes of the competition were to get pupils in these *Youthbridge schools* to think about the environment and to draw or paint an environmentally friendly family house including its surrounding area, and to write, in German, a 200-word description of their design. (Excerpts from these German texts are on the inner last page). We selected 13 designs for this calendar each of which is rewarded with a cash prize of £95.
